- This is the set time of favor for True Praise Family Worship Center (TPFWC) churches, Walking in Vision Family Outreach Educational Center, Inc. (WIVFOEC) youth department/outreach, Kingdom Dominion Fellowship of Pastors and Churches (KDFPC) fellowship alliance, and the body of Christ (Psalm 102:13).
- 2. These ministries inherit the souls of thousands who are spiritually and economically lost (Psalms 2:8).
- 3. TPFWC, and its outreach branches WIVFOEC and KDFPC, operate in integrity and shows favor to others; it guides its affairs with discretion (Psalm 112:5).
- 4. According to the scripture in Proverbs 29:18, "where there is no vision, the people perish..." The mission given to our Pastor by God is...
 - To build and establish True Praise Family Worship Center churches as interdenominational institutions that ministers to the entire man... spirit, soul and body.
 - To build churches with classrooms, counseling rooms, prayer rooms, fellowship hall, performance art centers, and administrative offices.
 - To provide a Bible training schools to teach our young men, women, and children the truth of the Word and prepare them for effective ministry.
 - To broadcast the Word of God via television, internet, and radio. (Word Radio & 92.7)
 - To establish a prayer line with full time counselors. (Minister April Stephenson)
 - To establish food banks in which to feed the hungry. (Interim: Elder Letty Butler)
 - To offer clothing banks to assist those in need of clothing. (Interim: Elder Letty Butler)
 - To build and establish rehabilitation centers with a minimum of 100 disciples fully trained.
 - To build shelters to offer housing for the homeless.
 - To have a fully trained missions team.
 - To bring men and women out of the strongholds of tradition and bring them back to the fundamental truths of God's Word.
 - To provide a nursery, as a means in which to offer safe supervision as well as teach the principles of growing up in God's Word.

- 5. As an interdenominational institution that ministers to the entire man... spirit, soul and body, TPFWC, and its outreach branches WIVFOEC, and KDFPC are blessed and favored of God to expand its outreach without hindrances of any kind (Deuteronomy 33:23; Isaiah 54:2-3).
- 6. Partners, Pastors, Churches, Ministries, and members of KDFPC are blessed and highly favored because of their faithful support of and association with TPFWC (Exodus 12:36; 1 Corinthians 9:11-14, 23; Philippians 1:7; 4:10-19).
- 7. Laws work in favor of TPFWC because Jesus is this ministry's advocate (Esther 8:5; Romans 8:34; Hebrews 7:22-25).
- Because TPFWC intercedes for and offers thanks to God on behalf of all those in authority, this ministry finds favor with local, national and international leaders and governments. As a result, this ministry spearheads the body of Christ in quietness, peace, godliness and honesty (1 Timothy 2:1-3).
- 9. TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC is able to pay every bill on time every time, because God supplies every need (Philippians 4:19).
- 10. The Executive Staff is graced, anointed and equipped to take TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC to every level that God has ordained. They speak wisely and operate in the fruit of kindness in all of TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC affairs (Proverbs 31:16, 20, 26).
- 11. TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC and its members are graced to produce and promote community services that speak God's Word in season to those who are weary and in need of a solution (Isaiah 50:4).
- 12. TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC is graced to help maximize the visions of other ministries and ministers and fulfill its commitment to use the transforming power of God to affect peoples, communities and cultures with the Gospel of Jesus, the Anointed One, ultimately changing lives as we build the house of worship together (Proverbs 27:17, Proverbs 29:18; Habakkuk 2:2-3).
- 13. TPFWC and its committed, active, and faithful member ministries and ministers are a minimum of 1,000 strong. They operate in excellence, faith and integrity, and find favor in the sight of God and men (Proverbs 11:27; 12:2).
- 14. KDFPC and its committed, active, and faithful alliance is a minimum of 100 strong. Each pastor, church, and ministry operate in excellence, faith and integrity, and find favor in the sight of God and men (Proverbs 11:27; 12:2).
- 15. As the Lord's house, TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC is a people magnet, favored to draw thousands of members from the north, south, east and west (Isaiah 2:2-3).

- 16. TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC have everything needed to fulfill God's perfect will. God adds to this church family daily, so TPFWC has 1,000 committed, active and faithful members (Acts 2:47).
- 17. TPFWC, WIVFOEC, and KDFPC members and alliances are faithful with the little (Luke 19:17). They are 100-percent tithers; as such, they are connected to God's power and receive a minimum of 100-fold return on the seed they sow.
- 18. Pray that your pastor will always have a passion to know Christ more intimately. Prayer: Father, help our pastor to know Christ and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in His sufferings (Phil. 3:10). Since we know of his faith in the Lord Jesus and his love for all the saints, may we never stop giving thanks for him, always remembering him in our prayers. We will keep asking that You, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, will give him the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that he may know You better (Eph. 1:15-17).
- 19. Pray that your pastor will minister out of a humble spirit. Prayer: Lord God Almighty, would You help our pastor to humble himself before You and under Your mighty hand, so that You will lift him up (Jas. 4:10; 1 Pet. 5:6)? Guide him in what is right and teach him Your way (Psa. 25:9). May our congregation see that he is wise and understanding as shown by his good life, and by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom (Jas. 3:13). Father, You have said that the one You esteem is he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and who trembles at Your Word (Isa. 66:2). May our pastor be such a person!
- 20. **Pray that your pastor will minister from the Spirit's power. Prayer:** Gracious Father, may our pastor's messages and preaching come to us, not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that our faith might not rest on the wisdom of man, but upon Your power (1 Cor. 2:4-5). Help him never to depend upon his own might or power, but always upon Your Spirit, Lord Almighty (Zech. 4:6). May You, the God of hope, fill our pastor with all joy and peace as he trusts in you, so that he may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13).
- 21. **Pray that your pastor will be a man of prayer and of the Word so that he can live a holy and pure life. Prayer:** Glorious God, we pray that our pastor will seek You with all of his heart. Help him never to stray from Your commands. May he hide Your Word in his heart so that he will not sin against You (Psa. 119:10-11). Give him deep desire to meditate on Your precepts and to consider Your ways. May he delight in Your decrees and never neglect Your Word (Psa. 119:15-16). Give him understanding so that he will keep your law and obey it with all of his heart. Direct him in the path of Your commands where he will find delight. Turn his heart toward Your statutes and not toward selfish gain, and turn his eyes away from worthless things. Preserve his life according to Your Word (Psa. 119:34-37).
- 22. **Pray for your pastor's family. Prayer:** Gracious Lord, may our pastor fear You so that he will have a secure fortress that will always be a refuge for his children (Prov. 14:26). May he consistently teach his children to revere Your commands by following his example (Psa. 34:11), so

that they might be blessed (Psa. 112:1-2). Help him to manage his family well so that his children will obey him with proper respect (1 Tim. 3:4-5). May he love his wife just as Christ loved the Church (Eph. 5:25). Help him to be considerate and respectful to her so that nothing will hinder his prayers (1 Pet. 3:7). Faithful Lord, strengthen and protect our pastor and his family against the attacks of the enemy (2 Thess. 3:3), and may their household always choose to serve You (Josh. 24:15).

- 23. **Pray for protection against the schemes of the devil. Prayer:** Heavenly Father, help our pastor to be strong in Your mighty power. May he continually remember to clothe himself with Your armor so that he can take his stand against the devil's schemes. Help him to remember that his struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, authorities, and powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Help him to stand his ground and to stand firm with the belt of truth buckled around his waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with his feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the Gospel of peace. In addition, help him to daily take up the shield of faith so that he can extinguish all of the flaming arrows of the evil one. May he put on the helmet of salvation and use the sword of the Spirit, Your Word. Give him the desire to pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. Help him to be continually alert, and to keep on praying for all the saints (Eph. 6:10-18). Don't let the devil establish a foothold in any area of his life (Eph. 4:27). Help him to have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap (1 Tim. 3:7). May he continually submit himself to You, Father, and may he be self-controlled and alert in order to resist the devil, standing firm in the faith, so that the devil will flee (Jas. 4:7; 1 Pet. 5:8-9). Keep him from temptation and deliver him from the evil one, Lord (Matt. 6:13).
- 24. **Pray blessing into the life of your pastor and his family:** O Lord, our Rock and Redeemer, may the words of our pastor's mouth and the meditation of his heart be pleasing in Your sight (Psa. 19:14).
 - May You, O Lord, give our pastor the desire of his heart and make all of his plans succeed (Psa. 20:4).
 - Lord, our God, may Your favor rest upon our pastor and establish the work of his hands (Psa. 90:17).
 - God of hope, may You fill our pastor with all joy and peace as he trusts in You, so that he may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13).
 - Lord of peace, may You give our pastor and his family peace at all times and in every way (2 Thess. 3:16).
 - May You, the God of peace, equip our pastor with everything good for doing Your will, and may You work in him what is pleasing to You, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen (Heb. 13:20-21).
