Aged for 24 months in oak and at least another 24 months in bottle.

Tasting notes:

Clear and shiny appearance. Cherry-red colour with a violet rim.

Its bouquet contains subtle notes of very ripe red fruits with soft rounded balsamic hints and well-toasted smoky notes in the finish.

Strong, silky and elegant after long ageing, but at the same time fleshy with a good structure and very powerful and rounded tannins.

Pairing:

Ideal for accompanying all kinds of meat such as grilled meat, roast baby lamb, stews, casseroles and hard cheeses.
