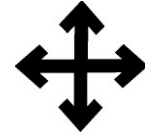

### **FROM OUR PASTOR**

In our Beacon one year ago, I shared information from the Rev. Carey Nieuwhof, a pastor and writer who is passionate about equipping congregations during changing times in order that they might thrive.

While Rev. Nieuwhof's information from a year ago remains helpful in these times of coronavirus, he has written an essay this spring about how clergy and congregations can navigate this new Covid19 landscape. He offers five suggestions to help us move forward:

1. Congregations and clergy need to become more agile. What was normal a year ago will not be returning anytime soon. We need to be able to pivot to this new reality. Change is the new normal. We need to be agile and flexible to remain faithful and relevant.
2. Remember that we've already reached new people. This is very true for St. Paul. People who were not "tuned in" to ministry at St. Paul prior to the coronavirus are now participating in our Daily Devotions and weekly worship through Facebook Live. In fact, in mid-May, we welcomed 11 new members to St. Paul!
3. Realize that some online attendees will stay online for a long time (and that has nothing to do with Covid19). Studies indicate that many people worship online for a year before finally mustering the courage to enter the sanctuary to worship.
4. On a similar vein, we need to resist the urge to make online worship attendees or non-attendees second class citizens to those who attend worship. At St. Paul, even after we reopen the sanctuary for worship, we will continue to record worship via Facebook Live. We will also continue to send the weekly worship packet to all our households. Even after we reopen, many of us will not be comfortable gathering. We need to make certain our wide welcome includes those in the sanctuary and those not in the sanctuary.
5. And finally, clergy and congregations need to let go of the need to be in control in order to be effective. We haven't encountered a situation like this in a century, so we need to let go enough to stay flexible and allow the Holy Spirit space.

With all of that being said, we are gearing up to open the sanctuary for worship on Sunday, June 21. There will be significant changes to how we worship in order to keep each other, our loved ones, and those around us safe. Worshiping on-site is a decision you and your family will need to prayerfully make.

Some of you will decide to return to the sanctuary for worship and some of you will choose to remain at home for worship. Either way you choose, God is still speaking among us. The Risen Christ offers us new life and new perspective. The Holy Spirit dances among us. Be well and know that you are loved incredibly!!!

### **JUNE MONTHLY MISSION – STRENGTHEN THE CHURCH**

Money donated to Strengthen the Church offering contributes to the continued expansion and revitalization of the United Church of Christ. Fifty percent of your offering stays with the Heartland Conference. (Ohio Conference is now known as Heartland Conference because our conference consists of members from Ohio, West Virginia and Northern Kentucky.) Fifty percent is sent to the national body of the UCC for grants towards new church starts, inspiring youth and young adults into leadership, and equipping pastors for ministry in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

The Rev. David Long-Higgins, Transitional Conference Minister of Heartland conference, writes, "This mission, on the national level, is helping assist churches who are struggling due to the Covid-19 pandemic. There are churches that need this kind of bridge to help them through this extraordinary season. At the Heartland Conference level, Strengthen the Church money especially helps support seminarians as we nurture a new generation of leadership for the church.

All scholarship recipients from last year have shared what a profound difference this support makes in their lives." Our own Katie Jackson received this help while in seminary.

Monies received from this mission also support the National Youth Event. 4000 youth ages 14-19 attend this event centering on faith, leadership, service and social justice. It is held every four years and was to be held at Purdue University this year. Due to COVID-19 this event has been postponed until Summer 2021.

**SENIOR PASTOR'S REPORT TO COUNCIL**  
**MAY 12, 2020**

Worship

(10:15am Sundays via Facebook Live on the Facebook St. Paul page)

May 31 - Pentecost Worship via Facebook Live.

June 7 - Trinity Sunday and Sacrament of Holy Communion - Facebook Live

June 14 - Rite of Confirmation - Pastor Dee and I will lead this service via Facebook Live in the sanctuary that Sunday morning. Only confirmands and parents (no siblings, grandparents, or mentors) will be allowed to join. Confirmands will read their Faith Statements as the sermon.

Blessing Pantry is well stocked AND busy. We now have volunteers to staff the Blessing Pantry hours. Donations of items and dollars continue to flow in.

Jeff Quellhorst, Roland Dicke, Dee, Barb and I meet each week to plan for the coming week. It is information from that meeting that is put into the letter that goes out each week with our worship packets. I've put together binders of information about getting the building/sanctuary ready for return to face-to-face worship. When it is time to return, we will need A LOT of volunteers to help make this happen. And, when we return, things will be different: singing will be out (singing voices project germs for up to 18 feet), we'll need sanitizer stations, hymnals, bibles, and pew cushions removed. And these guidelines are only the beginning of what will need to be done in order that we worship safely.

Art Camp is postponed until June 2021.

SALT internships are on hold until we see what the summer holds.

Dee and I are leading Daily Devotions via Facebook Live Monday through Friday at 11:30am. We have been utterly delighted by the amount of people who join us via Facebook.

Dee and I will lead Evening Vespers beginning Thursday, May 7 at 6:30pm via Zoom.

There will be a New Member Orientation on Saturday, May 16 at 10:00am. After that session, we will figure out the best way for new folk to join St. Paul Church.

I will take the second half of my sabbatical summer 2021. I will not leave while we are in the midst of this crisis.
