THEREFORE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY IS TO CONTACT THE CONSUMER HEALTH DIVISION AND CEASE OPERATIONS UNTIL THE IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD HAS BEEN ADDRESSED AND ALL NECESSARY CORRECTIONS HAVE BEEN MADE. TFER 229.171 (K) FAILURE TO CEASE OPERATION MAY RESULT IN CITATIONS AND A REINSPECTION FEE OF \$125.00.
