## <u>DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR</u> <u>LAPAROSCOPIC CHOLECYSTECTOMY</u>

- 1. Your incision is sutured with absorbable stitches that do not need to be removed, and covered with medical glue. You may shower over the incisions. No wound care is needed.
- 2. Expect some weight loss, lack of energy and tiredness for the first two (2) weeks. Consider one (1) week off work as a minimum. You may return to work and driving as soon as you feel ready.
- 3. You will receive a prescription for pain medication that you may take as often as every four (4) hours. *Do not drive while taking pain medications*. Side effects include constipation, drowsiness and/or nausea.
- 4. <u>Diet:</u> Bland food the day of surgery, then you may eat anything. You may experience some food intolerances after surgery for a short time.
- 5. Call (214) 823-2650 to make an office appointment for two (2) weeks after surgery.
- 6. Expect some shoulder pain it should resolve in 24-48 hours.
- 7. Take a fiber laxative and a stool softener daily until bowel movements return to normal.
