WHO THIS COURSE IS FOR:

- 2nd-5th grade students
- Anyone interested in learning a string instrument (violin or viola)
- No experience in music is necessary (though it's a plus!)

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Students will know basic music concepts and how to read music.
- Students will learn how to take care of their instrument, including daily. maintenance, tuning, and how to store their instrument when it's not being played.
- Students will learn how to practice effectively, how to set goals, and how to develop healthy practice habits.
- Students will learn how to play with correct posture and technique, both pizzicato (plucking) and arco (playing with the bow.
- Students will learn how to play basic pieces on their instruments, both as a solo and with a group.
- By the end of the class, the group will perform as a chamber orchestra in a fun and encouraging concert setting.

INSTRUMENT RENTALS:

- Keller Strings will be providing instrument rentals for the students and fitting students for their instrument during the first class.
- Students will rent their instruments directly from Keller Strings and keep them for the duration of the course (and hopefully longer!) to practice in between classes.
