



Tips & Maintenance

- 1: To clean your new Recyclit system if a spill occurs, simply hold the door open with one hand and wipe the spill using a cleaning cloth in your other hand, Rinse with disinfectant and or hot water, remembering to remove the bin out from under your Recyclit Hood outside to avoid filling with water.
- Never try to push anything bigger than the door size into the chute, as this will cause a blockage.
- 3: Big items like Pizza Cereal Boxes, we suggest that you fold or crush or place the cardboard box in sink and damping with water then fold box into smaller size.
- 4: Disposing of large Plastic bottles like 3lt or 4lt milk & Soft drink bottles etc. we suggest that you rinse with water and then compress and fit lid back on to ensure compaction.
- 5: If small plastic bags or shopping bags are to be used, ensure that they are biodegradable and not over filled, as this will also cause blockages.
- 6: While your council bin is being emptied, if necessary you can tip some hot water down the chute to rinse your Recyclit chute, keeping your system hygienic & clean.
- 7: Keeping the stainless steel flip door clean and shiny, use Window Cleaner, stainless steel wipes and a micro fibre cloth to avoid scratches, available from most super markets etc.
- 8: The correct positing of the wheelie bin under your Recyclit hood is also very important, to avoid insects & rodents entering your bin and allowing the unique venturi system to extract heat and odours from your system 24hrs a day. Position the wheelie bin so that the specially designed seal has coverage and slight pressure all the way around the top of the bin.
- 9: If you live in an area where ants are prevalent, your local super market store usually stock an environment friendly ant deterrent that can be applied to the top ring of the receptacle.
