**Pennsylvania Coalition of Taxpayer Associations announces  
Pennsylvania House of Representatives Endorsement**

**Berks County, Pennsylvania** – The Pennsylvania Coalition of Taxpayer Associations (PCTA), a statewide grassroots education finance reform alliance, today announced its endorsement of Sue Henry for the Pennsylvania Legislative District 121 seat in the November 6 general election.

In making its endorsement, the PCTA noted Ms. Henry's unequivocal support for House Bill 76, the Property Tax Independence Act, pending legislation developed by the people that will completely eliminate and equitably replace school property taxes and restructure a crumbling, antiquated education finance system.

David Baldinger, PCTA spokesperson, said: "For the past thirty years the General Assembly has continued to offer Pennsylvania homeowners nothing more than fraudulent, valueless approaches to property tax relief. Unlike the District 121 incumbent who in the past has strenuously opposed the Property Tax Independence Act and has ignored the hardship of overtaxed homeowners, Ms. Henry is firmly committed to the will of the people as expressed in House Bill 76, legislation that will forever abolish the onerous school property tax and will finally give legitimate, sustainable relief to beleaguered families. The PCTA is pleased to support candidates like Ms. Henry who are willing to work for true property tax elimination and replacement in a General Assembly that has historically avoided a resolution to this issue. The Pennsylvania Coalition of Taxpayer Associations wishes Sue Henry much success in her bid for the District 121 House seat."
