The purpose of the Career Direct[®] instrument is self-discovery. <u>Vocational Interests</u> – In this section you will see a ranking of your level of interest in 36 different work activity groups, 18 different school subjects, and 22 different occupation groups.

<u>Skills and Abilities</u> – This section ranks your natural skills in 14 areas and identifies your strongest skills and abilities.

<u>Values</u> – The final area of the assessment looks at three categories of personal values. Here, you will see your identified Work Environment Values, Work Expectation Values, and overall Life Values.

The report compiles the results of all of the sections and identifies *career occupations*. Each occupation is linked to thousands of job listings on O*NET Online.
