 - ☐ Won't leave your site right away
- ☐ Better conversion rates
 - ☐ Conversion is numbers game
 - ☐ More visitors, more possible conversions

 - ☐ Gain people's trust
- ☐ Better rankings on Google
 - ☐ Page speed is a ranking metric

 - ☐ Gives mobile suggestions
 - ☐ Gives desktop suggestions
 - ☐ Score for page speed
 - ☐ Check optimization suggestions
 - ☐ Address all problems
 - ☐ Reduce server response time
 - ☐ Eliminate render-blocking JS and CSS
 - ☐ Prioritize visible content
 - ☐ Leverage browser caching
 - ☐ Optimize images
 - ☐ Other issues
 - ☐ Check optimizations already present
 - ☐ You're on the right track

 - ☐ More info than PageSpeed Insights
 - ☐ Select from 1 of 4 locations
 - ☐ Gives performance grade
 - ☐ Detailed performance insights
 - ☐ Which content type has biggest size
 - ☐ Which content type make most requests
 - ☐ Waterfall analysis
- ☐ GTMetrix
 - ☐ Default (free) location is Vancouver

Good web hosting

- ☐ Thousands of web hosts
 - ☐ You get what you pay for
- ☐ How to choose right host
 - ☐ Understand your site's needs
 - ☐ How big is your site?
 - ☐ How many visitors do you get?
 - ☐ What kind of content you publish?
 - ☐ Will you use CMS or static HTML?
 - ☐ Types of hosting
 - ☐ Shared hosting
 - ☐ Share with 100s or 1000s of sites
 - ☐ Cheapest option
 - ☐ VPS hosting
 - ☐ Share with fewer sites
 - ☐ Cheaper than dedicated hosting
 - ☐ Dedicated hosting
 - ☐ Rent entire server
 - ☐ Most expensive hosting
 - ☐ Compare hosting plans
 - ☐ Shop around
 - ☐ Check user reviews
 - ☐ Beware of biased reviews
 - ☐ Usually affiliates promoting
 - ☐ What's included in package?
 - ☐ How to get support?
 - ☐ Check uptime guarantee
 - ☐ Check renewal price
 - ☐ Look into the future
 - ☐ Can host grow with you?
 - ☐ Will it be easy to scale your site?

Caching Plugin

- ☐ Web caching
 - ☐ Store website files for later
 - ☐ Server will serve cached copy
 - ☐ Reduces server load
 - ☐ Helps speed up site
- ☐ Content delivery networks
 - ☐ Servers in different locations
 - ☐ Each location has cached copy of your site
 - ☐ Shorter distance between user and CDN server
 - ☐ Less latency
 - ☐ Site loads faster on browsers
- ☐ Caching plugin tips
 - ☐ Check with web host first
 - ☐ Use only one plugin
 - ☐ Check if plugin works
- ☐ Best caching plugins
 - ☐ W3 Total Cache
 - ☐ Good for experts
 - ☐ Plenty of options to choose from
 - ☐ Very powerful plugin
 - ☐ WP Super Cache
 - ☐ Good for beginners
 - ☐ Simpler user interface
 - ☐ Most important caching options included
 - ☐ WP Fastest Cache
 - ☐ Combine CSS and JavaScript files
 - ☐ Minify CSS and JavaScript
 - ☐ Supports Gzip compression
 - ☐ Hummingbird Page Speed Optimization
 - ☐ Full-page caching
 - ☐ Browser caching
 - ☐ Gravatar caching
 - ☐ Great if you have many comments

Files to reduce

- ☐ Images
 - ☐ Difference between web and print
 - ☐ Image optimization for web
 - ☐ Reduce image dimensions
 - ☐ Use appropriate image type
 - ☐ JPG
 - ☐ PNG
 - ☐ GIF
 - ☐ Compress image for web
 - ☐ Removes metadata
 - ☐ Removes unused color profiles
 - ☐ Image compression tools
 - ☐ TinyPNG/TinyJPG
 - ☐ Compressor.io
 - ☐ WP Smush plugin
- ☐ HTML
 - ☐ Minify HTML
 - ☐ Use HTMLCompressor.com
- ☐ CSS stylesheets
 - ☐ Minify CSS
 - ☐ Use CSSMinifier.com
 - ☐ Use image sprites
 - ☐ Put CSS at top of code
- ☐ JavaScript
 - ☐ Minify JavaScript
 - ☐ Use JSCompress.com
- ☐ PDF files
 - ☐ Compress PDF files
 - ☐ Use PDFCompressor.com
 - ☐ Microsoft office documents
 - ☐ Compress images inside documents
- ☐ Videos
 - ☐ Use third-party hosting
 - ☐ YouTube
 - ☐ Vimeo
 - ☐ Wistia
 - ☐ Compress video
 - ☐ Use Handbrake.io

Tap website configuration file

- ☐ What's .htaccess file
 - ☐ Your site's gatekeeper
 - ☐ May need to create from scratch
 - ☐ Can put .htaccess file in root and sub-directories
- ☐ Configure .htaccess
 - ☐ Enable Gzip compression
 - ☐ Enable browser caching
 - ☐ Disable hotlinking
 - ☐ Reduce redirects

WordPress optimization

- ☐ Keep WordPress updated
- ☐ Use fast, lightweight theme
- ☐ Keep plugins to minimum
- ☐ Optimize WordPress database
- ☐ Don't upload videos
- ☐ Break comments into pages
- ☐ Reduce post revisions
