WISH-TV's News 8 will simultaneously launch a new daily "We Stand Together" segment airing Monday through Friday during News 8 at 10pm. "We Stand Together" aims to give voice to a diverse group of stakeholders and will feature an interview with a different community leader each night. After their initial broadcast, these segments will be available on demand at <u>WISHTV.com</u> and <u>All INdiana Podcast Network</u>, as well as being available for use by our news gathering and media partners at the Indianapolis Recorder and Radio One.
