



Prepare for your presentation



EXPECTATIONS: Your presentation will be a short talk (2-3 min.) accompanied with pictures (no power point, just pictures) on your topic.

- It has to teach others about the culture you researched and its mask.
- It also has to answer your central question - why do people wear mask in culture.



When you present you will talk - you won't read. You can have flashcards to help you remember some ideas, you don't need to study your research - but you will have to talk.



TO PRESENT YOU NEED TO HAVE:

1. **Engaging introduction** - how can your audience fall in love with your presentation?
- Write it here in 5-6 sentences.
2. **Organization of ideas** - have 3 to 5 main ideas. To organize your ideas use the flashcards.
3. **Conclusions and your opinion on the topic** - write it here in 5-6 sentences.
4. **Plan:**
 - a. **What do you need for your presentation?**
 - Rehearse flash cards with main ideas to present.
 - Equipment (computer, projector, speakers, etc.)
 - Materials (paper, marker, etc.)
 - b. **How are you going to provide materials and equipment needed?**
 - Make a list with all you need and give it to your teacher with your name and the title of the presentation.
