SHORT BIOGRAPHY

The 22-year-old is currently completing her BA (Hons) Degree in Music, specialising in Composition and Arranging at School of Contemporary Music, LASALLE, College of the Arts. Being a former Singapore Symphony Children's Choir (SSCC) member during her childhood, Aisha has always had a passion for music and performing. Born and raised in Singapore, Aisha had graduated from the School of the Arts (SOTA), Singapore, attaining her International Baccalaureate Diploma in 2016. During her high school years, she developed an interest for songwriting other than performing. She is currently completing her BA (Hons) Degree in Music, specialising in Composition and Arranging at School of Contemporary Music, LASALLE, College of the Arts.

Before LASALLE, Aisha had obtained several awards at songwriting competitions. At 16 years of age, she placed 1st Runner up with an original song entitled 'The Home I Love, Singapore' as well as the Public Favourite Award at the Homesongs: Moments to Remember competition hosted by NEXUS, OCEAN BUTTERFLIES MUSIC in April 2014. She won 1st place with the same song at the I Write & Sing My Song local songwriting contest organized by the Cheng San Community Club in July 2014.

Noticed by her mentors, Aisha was given the opportunity to showcase her original contemporary song entitled 'Protector', where she performed as a key vocalist along with an ensemble in the SOTA Arts Showcase in 2015 at the SOTA Concert Hall. During the same year, she also performed jazz, pop tunes with SOTA's Inked Sun (Jazz/Pop Ensemble) as a key vocalist for the Jazz in July event at the Esplanade Concourse as well as rock tunes for the TONES event at SCAPE.

She placed 1st runner up with her song "Who We Are (As One) in the local songwriting contest, (RACIALIFUSIONICULTURE) RAFUSICUL organized by OnePeople.sg in August 2015. For placing in several songwriting contests, she was the first to be awarded the Special Achievement Award for Excellence (Non-Academic) in the music category by Yayasan Mendaki in September 2015. She also was invited to perform at the annual Goh Chok Tong Youth Promise & Special Achievement Award for Excellence (Non-Academic) Ceremony organized Yayasan Mendaki in both 2015 and 2016.

In June 2017, Aisha released a digital EP album, *Epitome of Love*, that was self-produced, self-written and arranged at 19 years of age. She amassed over 28k streams on Spotify and gathered 1.2k followers on Instagram.
